

What is myON?

myON is a digital reading application that enables students to read anytime and anywhere, 24/7, including weekends, holidays, school breaks, and summer vacation.

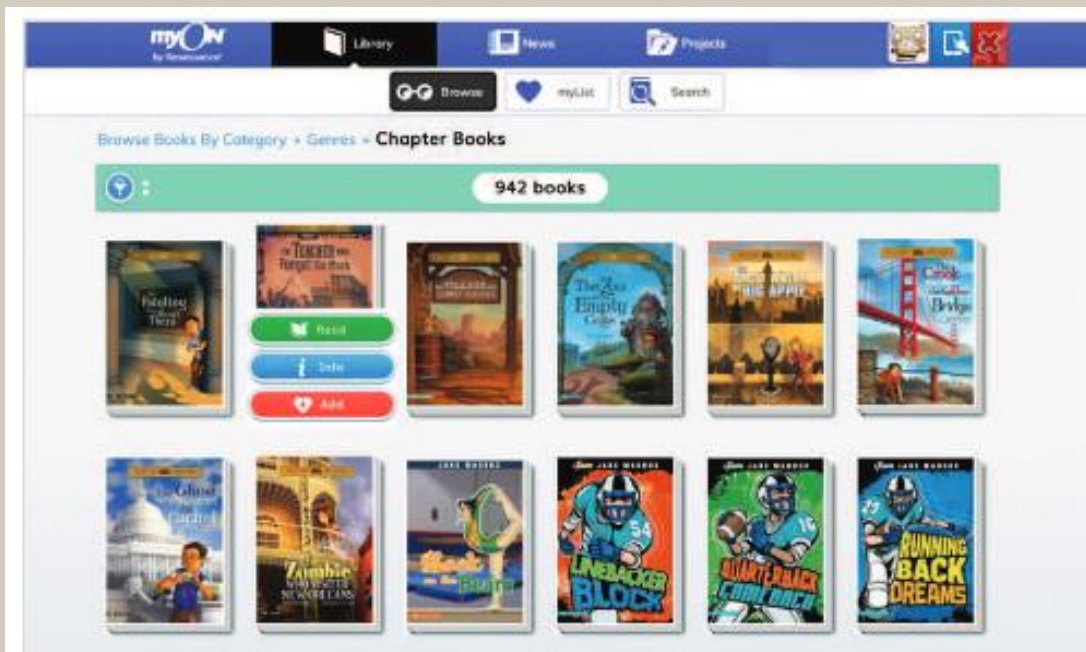
myON Use

- All of our partners, children, and families have free access. Including ESSS children and families
- Will need access to a device other than a phone
- Will need internet access, but may upload books to read while offline
- Over 6,000 digital texts pre-k through 12th grade

Getting started

I will share login instructions for children/families in our program.

Once children log in, they can read books within the myON digital library and daily news articles from myON News.



Digital library

Students can browse or search the myON digital library to find books on a variety of topics and themes.

They can:

- Read books online on any web-enabled device that is connected to the Internet
- Read books offline with free mobile apps
- Read the same book as many times as they want to read it
- Use optional reading supports including audio, text highlighting, and an embedded dictionary

*Books are available in English and Spanish.

News articles

Students can access myON News to read about current events and other timely topics.

They can:

- Choose from five daily, age-appropriate news articles written just for them and reviewed by a child psychologist
- Access optional audio and multimedia resources connected to each article, including maps, slideshows, videos, and information about the writer
- Extend their knowledge of news topics by reading recommended books from the myON digital library
- Take a brief quiz at the end of the article and get instant feedback on their answers.

*Articles are available in English, French, and Spanish.
